# Wines by the Glass



## White Wines

**Ruffino** \$11  
*Pinot Grigio*  
*Veneto, Italy - 2021*

Fresh and complex, showing refined notes of sage and mint accompanied by an elegant minerality typical of Pinot Grigio.

**Santa Margherita** \$15  
*Pinot Grigio*  
*Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy - 2020*

The wine is dry with intense aromas and appealing flavors of Golden Delicious apples and citrus with a long, multi-layered finish.

**Matua** \$11  
*Sauvignon Blanc*  
*Marlborough, New Zealand - 2021*

This classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is deliciously pure, bursting with citrus notes with a hint of grapefruit & basil. The palate is fresh and vibrant with concentrated blackcurrant leaf and a hint of nettle and green melon.

**Duckhorn Vineyards** \$15

*Sauvignon Blanc*  
*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2021*

This rich and elegant Sauvignon Blanc was blended with Sémillon to add depth and complexity. Fermented and aged using both stainless steel and French oak, it offers ripe citrus and tropical flavors, refreshing acidity and Sémillon-driven silkiness.

**Dr. Loosen** \$11  
*Riesling*  
*Mosel, Germany - 2021*

Light, spritzy, tangy, clean, refreshing, low alcohol, a real delight. Fresh pear, lemon & apple flavors are forward & fruity in this easy-quaffing dry Riesling.

**Josh Cellars Reserve** \$12  
*Chardonnay*  
*North Coast California, USA - 2020*

The wine is elegant, crisp, and well-balanced resulting from the region's warm, sunny days and cool nights influenced by its close proximity to the Pacific Ocean. The nose of this wine showcases bright citrus, lemon, and peach. On the palate, flavors of lemon zest, peach, and vanilla with a lingering, pleasant finish.

**Robert Mondavi** \$15

*Chardonnay*  
*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2018*

Experience the complexity of intense, vibrant flavors like fresh pineapple, lemon, and guava, complemented by notes of honey and cream, creating a rich and intricate profile.

**Conundrum by Caymus** \$13  
*White Blend*  
*California, USA - 2021*

A beautiful light hue, this wine opens with the evocative scents of apricot, pear and honeysuckle, as well as bright notes of orange and lemon meringue pie.

**Luca Bosio** \$10  
*Moscato*  
*Asti-Piedmont, Italy - 2021*

This vintage has an intense floral aroma, followed by ripe fruits, including green apple, pear and pineapple. There also are slight hints of acacia and honey. It is fresh-tasting, refreshing and nicely sweet.

## Red Wines

**Génération 1905** \$11

*Grenache*  
*Vin du France, France - 2020*

Ruby red with purple highlights. Delicate yet persistent violet notes typical of Sangiovese wines. Deep fruity plum flavors with intense sweet cherry flavors.

**Noble Vines "667"** \$11  
*Pinot Noir*  
*California, USA - 2021*

Appealing aromas of black cherry, blackberry and bittersweet cocoa. Plush tannins and balanced acidity support core flavors of ripe Bing cherry, juicy plum and delicate hints of vanilla and oak.

**Meiomi** \$15  
*Pinot Noir*  
*California, USA - 2021*

A rich garnet color with a ruby edge, the wine opens to reveal lifted fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, and vanilla, along with toasty oak notes. Expressive boysenberry, blackberry, dark cherry, juicy strawberry, and toasty mocha flavors lend complexity and depth on the palate.

**Sterling** \$11

*Merlot*  
*California, USA - 2021*

Lush and well-spiced, with sinewy power to the dried red currant, plum blackberry cassis and raspberry flavors. Notes of slate and hot stone show on the chiseled finish.

**Josh Cellars Reserve** \$12  
*Cabernet Sauvignon*  
*North Coast California, USA - 2019*

The bouquet is bursting with dark fruits and roasted nuts, with aromas of fresh black cherries, blackcurrant, rose petal, and roasted walnuts. Palate has rich flavors of black cherries, toasted hazelnuts, fresh sage, mocha, and subtle vanilla and oak flavors.

**Bonanza - Lot 6** \$13  
*Cabernet Sauvignon*  
*California, USA - 2019*

Ripe blueberries and blackberries take center stage for this flavor show. This luscious fruit is backed by vanilla, dark chocolate, and cassis coming shortly after.

**Marques del Sur** \$11

*Reserve de Familia*  
*Malbec*  
*Mendoza, Argentina - 2020*

Plum and raspberry aromas mingle elegantly with vanilla notes from the oak. Well balanced, exhibits sweet tannins and a velvety finish.

**19 Crimes** \$11  
*Red Blend*  
*South Eastern Australia - 2021*

Intense lifted vanilla aromatics balanced with ripe red to dark berry fruits. Full and round on the palate with a distinct sweetness giving a rich and round mouth feel. The vanilla aromatics carry through on the palate and compliment subtle flavors of chocolate and a cedary spice.

## Rose

**Chateau Gigery** \$12

*Rosé*  
*Côtes de Provence, France - 2021*

Very pale salmon hue. Watermelon, orange zest, pink grapefruit, celery, and lavender on the nose. Wonderful, crisp palate boasting lots of acidity and minerality. Strawberry, watermelon, raspberry, citrus pith, green herbs, and sea shell. Mostly dry, but very fruity and exceptionally refreshing.

## Sparkling Wines

**Gloria Ferrer** \$13

*Brut*  
*Sonoma, California, USA - 2020*

Vibrant and expressive, with lively apple and cinnamon brioche aromas leading to elegantly complex piecrust, strawberry and spice flavors that linger.

**Segura Viudas** \$10

*Brut Reserva*  
*Catalunya, Spain*

Elegant and persistent mousse. The aromas are of white fruits, citrus and tropical fruits, and light floral aromas with medim body and long finish.

**Villa Sandi** \$11

*Prosecco il Fresco*  
*Vadobbiadene Veneto, Italy*

Very pale straw yellow hue and fine, persistent perlage. Intensely fruity aroma with clear hints of ripe golden apple. Flavor is fresh, slightly sweetish, and soft to the palate with an agreeably fruity and harmonious finish.



# White Wines



## Pinot Grigio/Pinot Gris

**Ruffino** \$49

*Veneto, Italy - 2021*  
Fresh and complex, showing refined notes of sage and mint accompanied by an elegant minerality typical of Pinot Grigio.

**Cavaliere de Oro** \$52

*Veneto, Italy - 2021*  
Fragrant notes of floral cultivate a pleasantly sweet aroma with ripe mango and notes of honey. This wine has a low level of acidity and exhibits a strong finish.

**Barone Fini** \$56

*Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy - 2021*  
Delicate floral aromas with notes of lemon delight the nose. Refreshing flavors of honeydew and ripe apples are balanced with a bright acidity and warm minerality. Mouthfeel is crisp and lingering.

**Santa Margherita** \$67

*Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy - 2021*  
The wine is dry with intense aromas and appealing flavors of Golden Delicious apples and citrus with a long, multi-layered finish. With a medium body, it is versatile to pair with everything from salads to chicken or grilled fish.

**Alois Lageder Terra Alpina** \$72

*Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy - 2020*  
Crisp, clean and linear, this snappy, savory white features white-spring-flower, ripe pear and lemon-zest sensations.

**Attens** \$65

*Friuli, Italy - 2022*  
The nose expresses great personality with fresh aromas of white peach, citrus peel and wildflowers as well as definite scents of sap, thyme and toasted bread. In its structured body we find a wine with a balanced, complex flavour and a persistent finish of white pepper, avocado and walnut.

**Heim** \$56

*Alsace, France - 2020*  
Its finesse and distinction make it a great wine for gastronomy. Great apricot and dried white fruit aromas.

**A to Z** \$76

*Oregon, USA - 2021*  
Refreshing and light on the palate. Aromas of Meyer lemon, lemon verbena, tangerine, apricot, peach, apple, pear, quince, melon and honeysuckle add a hint of sweetness to the air around it. The weight is impeccable with perfect balance and integration hitting all points of the palate. Incredibly versatile at the dinner table with flavors of golden apple, roasted coconut, citrus and pineapple appealing to the last splash in the glass.

## Sauvignon Blanc

**Matua** \$49

*Marlborough, New Zealand - 2021*  
This classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is deliciously pure, bursting with citrus notes with a hint of grapefruit & basil. The palate is fresh and vibrant with concentrated blackcurrant leaf and a hint of nettle and green melon.

**Kim Crawford** \$70

*Marlborough, New Zealand - 2022*  
Fresh and juicy with ripe, tropical flavors of passion fruit, melon, and stone fruit. Each sip of wine reveals classic Marlborough sauvignon blanc aromas of lifted citrus, tropical fruit, and crushed herbs, along with vibrant acidity and plenty of weight and length on the palate.

**Rodney Strong** \$67

*Charlottes Home Estate  
Sonoma County, California, USA - 2019*  
Fresh, bright and crisp, this Sauvignon Blanc is a wine of balance, richness and aromatic complexity. Leading with zesty citrus notes of grapefruit, Meyer lemon and a light grassiness, this wine gives way to more tropical fruit and melon characteristics.

**Les Ombelles** \$73

*Pouilly-Fume - Loire, France - 2021*  
This wine has the aromas of a smoky gun flint notes and tomato leaves mix with asparagus and gooseberry. The palate has a fine mineral acidity and plenty of character.

**Emmolo by Caymus** \$79

*California, USA - 2021*  
A translucent yellow hue, this wine features clean, bright scents of wet stone and citrus blossom, with subtle notes of nectarine, newly ripened honeydew, tangerine, and a hint of guava. Entry on the palate is lean, then expands with flavors of lime zest and mouthwatering citrus.

**Duckhorn Vineyards** \$67

*North Coast, California, USA - 2021*  
This rich and elegant Sauvignon Blanc was blended with Sémillon to add depth and complexity. Fermented and aged using both stainless steel and French oak, it offers ripe citrus and tropical flavors, refreshing acidity and Sémillon-driven silkiness.

**Marcel Martin** \$75

*Sancerre La Chenaye - Loire, France - 2020*  
Balanced, floral nose, with pineapple notes on the palates and butter/oak hints.

## Chardonnay

**Florent Descombes** \$51

*Cotes de Beaune - Burgundy, France - 2020*  
There's a subtle chalkiness to the nose of this wine, grounded by a core of white peach, apple and clementine aromas and flavors.

**Clou de Passy** \$67

*Chablis, France - 2020*  
A lifted sense of hayflower and lemon peel signals ripeness right away on this wine's open nose. Refreshing acidity and long finish corner its quality.

**Mer Soleil** \$82

*Silver Unoaked  
Monterey County, California, USA - 2020*  
Deep lemon color with aromas of citrus, stone fruits and yeasty notes. On the palate flavors of ripe apple, lemon and peach with ripe red apple flavors.

**Chateau Montelena** \$163

*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2019*  
Aromas of ripe peach, green apple, and honeydew. Next comes a touch of vanilla, lavender and orange blossom, with an underlying note of star jasmine. The concentration of the wine is evident on the palate: the rich viscosity is cut by bright acid and layers of kiwi, grapefruit, and soft minerality. The finish is pure bliss with a touch of sweet oak and lemon curd that just doesn't quit.

**Liberty School** \$67

*Paso Robles, California, USA - 2019*  
Fresh aromas of lemon peel and pear are accented by notes of caramel that add a touch of richness with this Californian chardonnay

**Penfolds Koonunga Hill** \$53

*Barossa Valley, South Australia - 2022*  
This wine features tropical fruits on the nose, such as bananas and mango. A bit creamy and buttery on the palate.

**Josh Cellars Reserve** \$56

*North Coast California, USA - 2021*  
The wine is elegant, crisp, and well-balanced resulting from the region's warm, sunny days and cool nights influenced by its close proximity to the Pacific Ocean. The nose of this wine showcases bright citrus, lemon, and peach. On the palate, flavors of lemon zest, peach, and vanilla with a lingering, pleasant finish.

**Paul Hobbs** \$129

*Russian River Valley, California, USA - 2018*

This wine is made in a bold, lush style, layered in toasted oak, golden apple, pear and cinnamon. A creamy texture rounds out the finish.

**Robert Mondavi** \$67

*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2018*  
Indulge in the richness of this intense Chardonnay, boasting lively notes of fresh pineapple, zesty lemon, and tropical guava, accented by hints of honey and cream. A beautifully complex and vibrant experience awaits.

**Beringer Chardonnay** \$74

*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2020*  
Plush and creamy, aromas and flavors of tart citrus lead with hints of white pear, delicious apple and a bit of lemon meringue, caramel and toasted almonds.

**Prisoner Chardonnay** \$103

*Carneros, California, USA - 2021*  
Bursting with aromas of vanilla, crème brûlée, and baked apple. Full-bodied and rich on the palate, flavors of pineapple and toasted oak integrate nicely with the balanced acidity and smooth finish.

## Ramey \$153

*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2014*  
Classic Hyde Vineyard traits of delicate white flowers, tangerine zest, honey, and cinnamon. Poised and energetic, this wine is citrus-driven full bodied and long lasting.

## Far Niente \$177

*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2020*  
Opens with delicate aromas of citrus blossom, honeydew melon, pear, flint and toasted almonds. The entry is silky with pear and citrus flavors. Refreshing acidity leads to a juicy finish, layered with toasted oak.

## Rombauer Carneros \$114

*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2021*  
Enticing aromas of vanilla, peach and mango are layered with apricots, creme brûlée, butter and a slight minerality. Those scents are echoed as flavors on the creamy, rich palate, along with peach, pie crust and baking spices. The long, smooth finish is marked by mouthwatering acidity.

## Distinct Whites

### Portia by Faustino \$52

*Verdejo*  
*Rueda, Spain - 2021*  
The nose is intense and complex, with notes of tropical fruit and bone, such as peach, with citrus touches and pleasant herbaceous notes. In the mouth it is fine and elegant, with a very balanced passage, with slight bitter nuances. It has a long finish with herbaceous notes.

### Frescobaldi \$66

*Chardonnay & Pinot Bianco*  
*Pomino - Tuscany, Italy - 2022*  
A delicate and elegant wine with gentle floral aromas combined with fruity notes of sweet Williams pear, apple, grapefruit and fragrant lemon.

### Casa Rojo La Marimorena \$52

*Albariño*  
*Rias Baixas-Galicia, Spain - 2021*  
Straw colour with bright and clean legs. The nose shows medium high intensity, a bit of citric notes, lemon, grapefruit and some exotic hints of mango. The mouth is well balanced, bodied, round texture, medium-low acidity and a long warm finish.

### Stags' Leap \$95

*Viognier*  
*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2020*  
A refreshing, full-bodied wine with bright stone fruit aromas of citrus blossom, ripe peach, and just a hint of apricot. Awesome little wine.

### Heim Impérial \$49

*Pinot Blanc*  
*Alsace, France - 2019*  
Pale gold. Expressive and fruity nose, with floral and white fruit notes. Round, balanced and delicate, one of the famous wines from the Alsace.

### Chateau Respide \$55

*Graves Blanc*  
*France - 2019*  
Floral and fruity, grapefruit, passion fruit, boxwood, juniper, white flowers, acacia and roasted nuts. Powerful, round, and lively!

### Conundrum by Caymus \$62

*White Blend*  
*California, USA - 2021*  
A beautiful light hue, this wine opens with the evocative scents of apricot, pear and honeysuckle, as well as bright notes of orange and lemon meringue pie.

### Dr. Loosen Riesling \$49

*Mosel*  
*Germany - 2021*  
Light, spritzy, tangy, clean, refreshing, low alcohol, a real delight. Fresh pear, lemon & apple flavors are forward & fruity in this easy-quaffing dry Riesling.

### Chateau St. Michelle \$59

*Riesling*  
*Washington, USA - 2021*  
A dry, refreshing style of Riesling with beautiful fruit flavors, crisp acidity and an elegant finish. It offers inviting sweet citrus aromas and flavors.

### Luca Bosio \$45

*Moscato*  
*Asti - Piedmont, Italy - 2022*  
This vintage has an intense floral aroma, followed by ripe fruits, including green apple, pear and pineapple. Notice slight hints of acacia and honey. It is fresh-tasting, refreshing and nicely sweet.

### Ritter \$43

*Grüner Veltliner*  
*Niederösterreich, Austria - 2021*  
A wine full of elegance and finesse, with a floral perfume and a refreshing zip. With a refreshing acidity and a lovely stoney minerality.

# Red Wines

## Pinot Noir

### Kim Crawford \$70

*Marlborough, New Zealand - 2020*  
This Pinot Noir has a bright colour and a sweet floral bouquet of red cherries, strawberry and spicy aromas. Medium bodied, bright acidity a light elegant Pinot.

### Louis Jadot Bourgogne \$70

*Burgundy, France - 2020*  
This is an exceptionally elegant Pinot with complex aromas of plums, raspberries and cherries and fresh red fruit flavors in the mouth with earthy floral, mushroom and mineral notes and balance acidity.

### Noble Vines "667" \$56

*California, USA - 2021*  
Appealing aromas of black cherry, blackberry and bittersweet cocoa. Plush tannins and balanced acidity support core flavors of ripe Bing cherry, juicy plum and delicate hints of vanilla and oak.

### Elouan \$81

*Oregon, USA - 2019*  
Dark ruby in color, the wine powers up with aromatics of a plum pie, mixed-berry jam and smokey, game-bird characteristics that set the stage for flavors of vanilla cherry and black berry.

### Crossbarn by Paul Hobbs \$112

*California, USA - 2020*  
On the palate, tart acid with flavors of cherry and Santa Rosa plum. Juicy and spicy with earthy notes of black tea and red clay. A light to medium weight on the palate, long refreshing finish.

### Rodney Strong Estate \$83

*Sonoma County, California, USA - 2018*  
Lovely aromas of red fruit, floral and earth. With a soft and silky texture, on the palate dark cherry, cranberry, and baking spice characteristics shine through with balance, acidity and a nice lingering finish.

### Robert Mondavi \$103

*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2018*  
Vibrant flavors of black cherry, red plum, and red cherry fruit with a hint of tart cranberry. Great depth and persistency.

### Etude Heirloom \$189

*Carneros - Napa Valley, California, USA - 2019*  
Pure fruit aromas of black cherry and red raspberry with notes of floral spice on the nose of this graceful Pinot Noir. The palate bursts with generous red fruit with baking spice notes that lead to soft, velvety tannins. The wine has an alluring minerality that adds racy verve and liveliness to this Pinot.

### Meiomi \$74

*California, USA - 2021*  
A rich garnet color with a ruby edge, the wine opens to reveal lifted fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, and vanilla, along with toasty oak notes. expressive boysenberry, blackberry, dark cherry, juicy strawberry, and toasty mocha flavors lend complexity and depth on the palate.

### Belle Glos Las Alturas \$133

*Santa Lucia Highlands, California, USA - 2020*  
This powerful Pinot Noir offers intense aromas of black plum, purple flowers and toasty melted caramel. The palate is loaded with herbs and spice, from tarragon, sage and bay leaf to cardamom and anise, as well as a rich boysenberry-jam core.

### EnRoute by far Niente \$170

*Russian River Valley, USA - 2018*  
The magic microclimates and the proximity to the cool Pacific Ocean create vineyards and conditions that work in concert to create some of the most unique Pinot Noirs. Taste the rich viscosity of flavors of dark currant, plum tart and cherry pastry. Graphite and hot stone notes emerge midpalate, with dark chocolate details and hints of pepper on the finish.

## Sangiovese

**Ruffino** \$49

*Tuscany, Italy - 2019*

Ruby red with purple highlights. Delicate yet persistent violet notes typical of Sangiovese wines. Deep fruity plum flavors with intense sweet cherry flavors.

**Cavaliere d'Oro** \$67

*Chianti Classico - Tuscany, Italy - 2019*

Light garnet color. Aromas of nutmeg, cassis, and earth with a silky, lively, medium body and a smooth, brisk underripe cherry and violet aromas.

**Frescobaldi Nipozzano** \$80

*Chianti Rufina Riserva - Tuscany, Italy - 2019*

Its intense ruby red color gives it a bold and elegant character. Red berries and notes of ripe citrus fruit give way to a delicately fruity finish.

**Castello di Gabbiano** \$76

*Chianti Classico Riserva - Tuscany, Italy - 2020*

A very pleasing and inviting aroma of cherry and strawberry plus nice touches of earth, vanilla and spice. The medium-bodied and well-structured wine tastes delicious and is chock-full of juicy black cherry, strawberry and plum with nicely integrated spice and more earthy notes.

**Tenuta Luce Lucente** \$84

*Tuscany, Italy - 2015 - 2020*

Wonderfully strong and enticing aromas of blackberry and raspberry plus leather, spice and licorice. The wine tastes rich and luscious with tons of delicious ripe, juicy fruit countered by dusty tannins. A fabulous long, dry finish.

**Greppone Mazi by Ruffino** \$123

*Brunello di Montalcino*

*Tuscany, Italy - 2017*

Full bodied wine with notes of incense, cocoa, sweet tobacco, and spicy black pepper. The palate is refined with an elegant and complex structure.

**Casanova di Neri "Tenuta Nuova"** \$226

*Brunello di Montalcino*

*Tuscany, Italy - 2015*

A bright, pure version, boasting raspberry, black cherry and blackberry flavors married to a fluid profile. The structure is present, yet both the lively acidity and fine-grained tannins are in harmony. The focus is really on the fruit here, with accents of graphite, earth, tobacco and underbrush.

## Red Zinfandel

**Vigneti del Salento** \$64

*Zolla Primitivo di Manduria*

*Puglia, Italy - 2020*

Rich aroma of dark berries, vanilla, oak, and hints of tobacco. Medium - full bodied. Low acidity. Mild tannins. Well balanced with a long finish.

**Gnarly Head Old Vine** \$56

*Lodi, California, USA - 2020*

A gnarly core of rich, jammy blackberries and mocha flavors with layers of spice and vanilla balanced by complex dark fruit aromas.

**Seghesio** \$92

*Sonoma County, California, USA - 2020*

A small amount of Petite Sirah is added to honor century-old traditions and to provide color and structure. The result is a wine that offers tantalizing raspberry, blueberry, classic briary and spicy flavors with a balance of components for which Seghesio wines are known.

**Beran** \$73

*Sonoma County, California, USA - 2017*

Rich and mouth-filling with ripe flavors of cherry, dark chocolate, coffee and coconut with fine-grained tannins and a persistent finish.

**8 Years in the Desert by Orin Swift** \$104

*Zinfandel Blend*

*Saint Helena Napa Valley, California, USA - 2020*

Rich and mouth-filling with ripe flavors of cherry, dark chocolate, coffee and coconut with fine-grained tannins and a persistent finish.

## Malbec

**Marques del Sur** \$49

*Reserva de Familia*

*Mendoza, Argentina - 2022*

Plum and raspberry aromas mingle elegantly with vanilla notes from the oak. Well balanced, exhibits sweet tannins and a velvety finish.

**Clos de Gamot** \$69

*Cahors, France - 2018*

Inky and slightly cloudy vermilion colour with thick clear legs. Nose of raspberry, ripe plum and red currant. Dry, with plenteous acid. Firm but silky tannins and high alcohol providing plenty of structure.

**Felino** \$77

*Mendoza, Argentina - 2020*

Showing a rich red color with purplish and bluish shades, this wine has a flowery aroma of red berries and vanilla. Notes of chocolate can be tasted in the mouth. Balanced acidity and freshness make this fine Malbec unique, and gently lead to a balanced aftertaste.

**Trivento Golden Reserve** \$68

*Mendoza, Argentina - 2019*

Purple red with deep violet tones. It has a bouquet of berry fruits, plum jam, coffee and tobacco notes. The wine is elegant and powerful on the palate with velvety tannins.

**Bramare** \$100

*Lujan de Cuyo-Mendoza, Argentina - 2020*

The color is deep red with violet hues. It has an intense spicy aroma of pepper, cloves, cinnamon and other spices, ripe black fruits and hints of roses.

*Uco Valley, Argentina - 2019*

Full bodied, this is a very complex & generous wine, with a great balance & a melange of flavors of sweaty meaty red berry fruit with plum, ethereal almond-infused ripe dark berry fruit, acid liquorice & baking spices.

**Red Schooner by Caymus** \$144

*Mendoza, Argentina - 2022*

This vibrant cherry red opens with a warm, alluring nose. Aromas of ripe plums mix with the rustic scents of the high desert - scrub brush, wild sage, saddle leather, and a hint of pomace. The palate is silky and smooth, with lush plums and grippy tannins that touch the side of the tongue.

This spicy, strongly perfumed wine is full of fruit and juicy acidity. It's dry and structured, with a firm backdrop of tannins.

*Grand Durif*

*Suisun Valley, California, USA - 2019*

Rich, enveloping scents of French plums and German chocolate cake. A hint of pomace, vanilla, and floral potpourri adds freshness to the nose, while the wood on this wine cradles but never defines the fruit. On the palate, dark berry flavors mingle with tannins, each expanding again and again to march the other.

**Stags' Leap** \$131

*Petit Sirah*

*Napa Valley, California, USA - 2019*

Very deep purple-black in color, it opens with notes of freshly crushed black cherries and black berries with touches of plum preserves, baking spices and tar. The palate is medium to full-bodied, very firm and grainy with a lively line to lift the peppery black fruit to a long finish.

Red ruby in colour. The nose is marked by notes of raspberry and crisp strawberries, and a touch of blackcurrant, violet and grey pepper.

*Barossa Valley, South Australia - 2019*

Medium-deep crimson. Blackberry, praline, herb, spice, cedar aromas with a hint of sage. Buoyant, concentrated wine with rich, voluminous blackberry, herb, brambly, dark chocolate flavours and supple, dry leafy tannins.
