## White Wines

**Corte Fresca** \$12

*Pinot Grigio*

*Venezie, Italy*

Green apple with peach and pear notes, into a finish with hints of elderflower. A super refreshing and delightful wine.

**Santa Margherita** \$16

*Pinot Grigio*

*Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy*

The wine is dry with intense aromas and appealing flavors of Golden Delicious apples and citrus with a long, multi-layered finish.

**Matua** \$12

*Sauvignon Blanc*

*Marlborough, New Zealand*

This classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is deliciously pure, bursting with citrus notes with a hint of grapefruit & basil. The palate is fresh and vibrant with concentrated blackcurrant leaf and a hint of nettle and green melon.

**Duckhorn Vineyards**

*Sauvignon Blanc*

*North Coast, California, USA*

This rich and elegant Sauvignon Blanc was blended with Sémillon to add depth and complexity. Fermented and aged using both stainless steel and French oak, it offers ripe citrus and tropical flavors, refreshing acidity and Sémillon-driven silkiness.

**Dr. Loosen**

*Riesling*

*Mosel, Germany*

Light, spritz, tangy, clean, refreshing, low alcohol, a real delight. Fresh pear, lemon & apple flavors are forward & fruity in this easy-quaffing dry Riesling.

**St. Francis**

*Chardonnay*

*Sonoma California, USA*

Flavors and aromas of Fuji apple, juicy pear, and honeydew melon shine in this refreshing, medium-bodied wine. Bright and crisp with a silky mouth-feel, it is beautifully balanced by a subtle touch of mineral, leading to a long, smooth finish.

**Clay Creek**

*Chardonnay*

*Central Valley, California, USA*

Ripe apple and pear with soft oak and a touch of vanilla. Smooth, medium-bodied, and well balanced.

**Conundrum by Caymus**

*White Blend*

*California, USA*

A beautiful light hue, this wine opens with the evocative scents of apricot, pear and honeysuckle, as well as bright notes of orange and lemon meringue pie.

**Luca Bosio**

*Moscato*

*Asti-Piedmont, Italy*

This vintage has an intense floral aroma, followed by ripe fruits, including green apple, pear and pineapple. There also are slight hints of acacia and honey. It is fresh-tasting, refreshing and nicely sweet.

## Red Wines

**Génération 1905**

*Grenache*

*Vin du France, France*

Ruby red with purple highlights. Delicate yet persistent violet notes typical of Sangiovese wines. Deep fruity plum flavors with intense sweet cherry flavors.

**Hahn**

*Pinot Noir*

*California, USA*

Bright cherry and raspberry with subtle spice and soft tannins. Smooth, approachable, and well balanced.

**Meiomi**

*Pinot Noir*

*California, USA*

A rich garnet color with a ruby edge, the wine opens to reveal lifted fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, and vanilla, along with toasty oak notes. Expressive boysenberry, blackberry, dark cherry, juicy strawberry, and toasty mocha flavors lend complexity and depth on the palate.

Lush and well-spiced, with sinewy power to the dried red currant, plum blackberry cassis and raspberry flavors. Notes of slate and hot stone show on the chiseled finish.

The bouquet is bursting with dark fruits and roasted nuts, with aromas of fresh black cherries, blackcurrant, rose petal, and roasted walnuts. Palate has rich flavors of black cherries, toasted hazelnuts, fresh sage, mocha, and subtle vanilla and oak flavors.

Ripe blueberries and blackberries take center stage for this flavor show. This luscious fruit is backed by vanilla, dark chocolate, and cassis coming shortly after.

*Malbec*

*Mendoza, Argentina*

Plum and raspberry aromas mingle elegantly with vanilla notes from the oak. Well balanced, exhibits sweet tannins and a velvety finish.

**19 Crimes**

*Red Blend*

*South Eastern Australia*

Intense lifted vanilla aromatics balanced with ripe red to dark berry fruits. Full and round on the palate with a distinct sweetness giving a rich and round mouth feel. The vanilla aromatics carry through on the palate and compliment subtle flavors of chocolate and a cedar spice.

## Rose

**Chateau Gigery**

*Rosé*

*Côtes de Provence, France*

Very pale salmon hue. Watermelon, orange zest, pink grapefruit, celery, and lavender on the nose. Wonderful, crisp palate boasting lots of acidity and minerality. Strawberry, watermelon, raspberry, citrus pith, green herbs, and sea shell. Mostly dry, but very fruity and exceptionally refreshing.

## Sparkling Wines

**Villa Sandi**

*Prosecco il Fresco*

*Vadobbiadene Veneto, Italy*

Very pale straw yellow hue and fine, persistent perlage. Intensely fruity aroma with clear hints of ripe golden apple. Flavor is fresh, slightly sweetish, and soft to the palate with an agreeably fruity and harmonious finish.

# White Wines

## Pinot Grigio/Pinot Gris

**Corte Fresca** \$52

Veneto, Italy

Green apple with peach and pear notes, into a finish with hints of elderflower. A super refreshing and delightful wine.

**Cavaliere de Oro** \$56

Veneto, Italy

Fragrant notes of floral cultivate a pleasantly sweet aroma with ripe mango and notes of honey. This wine has a low level of acidity and exhibits a strong finish.

**Barone Fini** \$59

Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy

Delicate floral aromas with notes of lemon delight the nose. Refreshing flavors of honeydew and ripe apples are balanced with a bright acidity and warm minerality. Mouthfeel is crisp and lingering.

**Santa Margherita**

Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy

The wine is dry with intense aromas and appealing flavors of Golden Delicious apples and citrus with a long, multi-layered finish. With a medium body, it is versatile to pair with everything from salads to chicken or grilled fish.

**Alois Lageder Terra Alpina** \$74

Trentino-Alto Adige, Italy

Crisp, clean and linear, this snappy, savory white features white-spring-flower, ripe pear and lemon-zest sensations.

**Attems** \$68

Friuli, Italy

The nose expresses great personality with fresh aromas of white peach, citrus peel and wildflowers as well as definite scents of sap, thyme and toasted bread. In its structured body we find a wine with a balanced, complex flavour and a persistent finish of white pepper, avocado and walnut.

**Heim**

Alsace, France

Its finesse and distinction make it a great wine for gastronomy. Great apricot and dried white fruit aromas.

**A to Z**

Oregon, USA

Refreshing and light on the palate. Aromas of Meyer lemon, lemon verbena, tangerine, apricot, peach, apple, pear, quince, melon and honeysuckle add a hint of sweetness to the air around it. The weight is impeccable with perfect balance and integration hitting all points of the palate. Incredibly versatile at the dinner table with flavors of golden apple, roasted coconut, citrus and pineapple appealing to the last splash in the glass.

## Sauvignon Blanc

**Matua** \$52

Marlborough, New Zealand

This classic Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is deliciously pure, bursting with citrus notes with a hint of grapefruit & basil. The palate is fresh and vibrant with concentrated blackcurrant leaf and a hint of nettle and green melon.

**Kim Crawford** \$71

Marlborough, New Zealand

Fresh and juicy with ripe, tropical flavors of passion fruit, melon, and stone fruit. Each sip of wine reveals classic Marlborough sauvignon blanc aromas of lifted citrus, tropical fruit, and crushed herbs, along with vibrant acidity and plenty of weight and length on the palate.

**Rodney Strong**

Charlottesville Home Estate

Sonoma County, California, USA

Fresh, bright and crisp, this Sauvignon Blanc is a wine of balance, richness and aromatic complexity. Leading with zesty citrus notes of grapefruit, Meyer lemon and a light grassiness, this wine gives way to more tropical fruit and melon characteristics.

**Les Ombelles** \$74

Pouilly-Fumé - Loire, France

This wine has the aromas of a smoky gun flint notes and tomato leaves mix with asparagus and gooseberry. The palate has a fine minerally acidity and plenty of character.

**Emmolo by Caymus**

California, USA

A translucent yellow hue, this wine features clean, bright scents of wet stone and citrus blossom, with subtle notes of nectarine, newly ripened honeydew, tangerine, and a hint of guava. Entry on the palate is lean, then expands with flavors of lime zest and mouthwatering citrus.

**Duckhorn Vineyards**

North Coast, California, USA

This rich and elegant Sauvignon Blanc was blended with Sémillon to add depth and complexity. Fermented and aged using both stainless steel and French oak, it offers ripe citrus and tropical flavors, refreshing acidity and Sémillon-driven silkiness.

**Marcel Martin**

Sancerre La Chenaye - Loire, France

Balanced, floral nose, with pineapple notes on the palate and butter/oak hints.

## Chardonnay

**Florent Descombes** \$54

Cotes de Beaune - Burgundy, France

There's a subtle chalkiness to the nose of this wine, grounded by a core of white peach, apple and clementine aromas and flavors.

**Clou de Passy** \$70

Chablis, France

Lifted aromas of hayflower and lemon peel signal ripeness on the open nose. The palate is crisp and refreshing with bright acidity, subtle mineral notes, and a long, clean finish that highlights its quality.

**Mer Soleil** \$84

Silver Unoaked

Monterey County, California, USA

Deep lemon color with aromas of citrus, stone fruits and yeasty notes. On the palate flavors of ripe apple, lemon and peach with ripe red apple flavors.

**Chateau Montelena** \$164

Napa Valley, California, USA

Ripe peach, green apple, and honeydew with hints of vanilla and citrus blossom. Bright acidity balances rich texture, leading to kiwi, grapefruit, and soft minerality, with a smooth oak-kissed finish.

**Penfolds Koonunga Hill** \$58

Barossa Valley, South Australia

Aromatic notes of ripe banana and mango open the wine, followed by a creamy, lightly buttery palate. Smooth and medium-bodied with soft texture, balanced acidity, and a gentle, satisfying finish.

**St. Francis**

Sonoma California, USA

Flavors and aromas of Fuji apple, juicy pear, and honeydew melon shine in this refreshing, medium-bodied wine. Bright and crisp with a silky mouthfeel, it is beautifully balanced by a subtle touch of mineral, leading to a long, smooth finish.

**Paul Hobbs**

Russian River Valley, California, USA

The quintessential Chardonnay; its medium gold color is followed by a rich, upfront bouquet of caramelized pineapple, tangerine, honeysuckle, spice, and a touch of toasted nuts.

**Black Stallion** \$72

Napa Valley, California, USA

This wine is made in a bold, lush style, layered in toasted oak, golden apple, pear and cinnamon. A creamy texture rounds out the finish.

**Clay Creek**

California, USA

Peach and ripe pear lead the way with notes of vanilla and toasted hazelnut. Smooth and medium-bodied with a rounded texture, balanced acidity, and a clean, polished finish.

**Beringer**

Napa Valley, California, USA

Plush and creamy, aromas and flavors of tart citrus lead with hints of white pear, delicious apple and a bit of lemon meringue, caramel and toasted almonds.

**Prisoner**

Carneros, California, USA

Bursting with aromas of vanilla, crème brûlée, and baked apple. Full-bodied and rich on the palate, flavors of pineapple and toasted oak integrate nicely with the balanced acidity and smooth finish.

Far Niente Chardonnay  
Napa Valley, California

# White Wines *Continued*

## Far Niente \$178

Napa Valley, California, USA

Opens with delicate aromas of citrus blossom, honeydew melon, pear, flint and toasted almonds. The entry is silky with pear and citrus flavors. Refreshing acidity leads to a juicy finish, layered with toasted oak.

## Rombauer Carneros \$115

Napa Valley, California, USA

Enticing aromas of vanilla, peach and mango are layered with apricots, creme brulee, butter and a slight minerality. Those scents are echoed as flavors on the creamy, rich palate, along with peach, pie crust and baking spices. The long, smooth finish is marked by mouthwatering acidity.

## Distinct Whites

### Portia by Faustino

Verdejo

Rueda, Spain

The nose is intense and complex, with notes of tropical fruit and bone, such as peach, with citrus touches and pleasant herbaceous notes. In the mouth it is fine and elegant, with a very balanced passage, with slight bitter nuances. It has a long finish with herbaceous notes.

### Frescobaldi

Chardonnay & Pinot Bianco

Pomino - Tuscany, Italy

A delicate and elegant wine with gentle floral aromas combined with fruity notes of sweet Williams pear, apple, grapefruit and fragrant lemon.

### Casa Rojo La Marimorena

Albariño

Rias Baixas-Galicia, Spain

Straw colour with bright and clean legs. The nose shows medium high intensity, a bit of citric notes, lemon, grapefruit and some exotic hints of mango. The mouth is well balanced, bodied, round texture, medium-low acidity and a long warm finish.

### Stags' Leap

Viognier

Napa Valley, California, USA

A refreshing, full-bodied wine with bright stone fruit aromas of citrus blossom, ripe peach, and just a hint of apricot. Awesome little wine.

### Heim Impérial

Pinot Blanc

Alsace, France

Pale gold. Expressive and fruity nose, with floral and white fruit notes. Round, balanced and delicate, one of the famous wines from the Alsace.

### Chateau Respine

Graves Blanc

France

Floral and fruity, grapefruit, passion fruit, boxwood, juniper, white flowers, acacia and roasted nuts. Powerful, round, and lively.

### Conundrum by Caymus

White Blend

California, USA

A beautiful light hue, this wine opens with the evocative scents of apricot, pear and honeysuckle, as well as bright notes of orange and lemon meringue pie.

### Dr. Loosen

Riesling

Mosel, Germany

Light, spritz, tangy, clean, refreshing, low alcohol, a real delight. Fresh pear, lemon & apple flavors are forward & fruity in this easy-quaffing dry Riesling.

### Chateau St. Michelle

Riesling

Washington, USA

A dry, refreshing style of Riesling with beautiful fruit flavors, crisp acidity and an elegant finish. It offers inviting sweet citrus aromas and flavors.

### Luca Bosio

Moscato

Asti - Piëmont, Italy

This vintage has an intense floral aroma, followed by ripe fruits, including green apple, pear and pineapple. Notice slight hints of acacia and honey. It is fresh-tasting, refreshing and nicely sweet.

# Red Wines

## Pinot Noir

### Kim Crawford

Marlborough, New Zealand

This Pinot Noir has a bright colour and a sweet floral bouquet of red cherries, strawberry and spicy aromas. Medium bodied, bright acidity a light elegant Pinot.

### Louis Jadot

Burgundy, France

This is an exceptionally elegant Pinot with complex aromas of plums, raspberries and cherries and fresh red fruit flavors in the mouth with earthy floral, mushroom and mineral notes and balance acidity.

### Hahn

California, USA

Notes of red and dark cherry, dried raspberry, and rhubarb pie are layered with subtle hints of spice and toasty oak. The palate is medium-bodied with silky, well-integrated tannins.

### Elouan

Oregon, USA

Dark ruby in color, the wine powers up with aromatics of a plum pie, mixed-berry jam and smokey, game-bird characteristics that set the stage for flavors of vanilla cherry and black berry.

### Crossbarn by Paul Hobbs

California, USA

On the palate, tart acid with flavors of cherry and Santa Rosa plum. Juicy and spicy with earthy notes of black tea and red clay. A light to medium weight on the palate, long refreshing finish.

### Rodney Strong Estate

Sonoma County, California, USA

Lovely aromas of red fruit, floral and earth. With a soft and silky texture, on the palate dark cherry, cranberry, and baking spice characteristics shine through with balance, acidity and a nice lingering finish.

### Robert Mondavi

Napa Valley, California, USA

Vibrant flavors of black cherry, red plum, and red cherry fruit with a hint of tart cranberry. Great depth and persistency.

### Etude Heirloom

Carneros - Napa Valley, California, USA

Pure fruit aromas of black cherry and red raspberry with notes of floral spice on the nose of this graceful Pinot Noir. The palate bursts with generous red fruit with baking spice notes that lead to soft, velvety tannins. The wine has an alluring minerality that adds racy verve and liveliness to this Pinot.

### Meiomi

California, USA

A rich garnet color with a ruby edge, the wine opens to reveal lifted fruit aromas of bright strawberry and jammy fruit, mocha, and vanilla, along with toasty oak notes. Expressive boysenberry, blackberry, dark cherry, juicy strawberry, and toasty mocha flavors lend complexity and depth on the palate.

### Belle Glos Las Alturas

Santa Lucia Highlands, California, USA

This powerful Pinot Noir offers intense aromas of black plum, purple flowers and toasty melted caramel. The palate is loaded with herbs and spice, from tarragon, sage and bay leaf to cardamom and anise, as well as a rich boysenberry-jam core.

### EnRoute by Far Niente

Russian River Valley, USA

The magic microclimates and the proximity to the cool Pacific Ocean create vineyards and conditions that work in concert to create some of the most unique Pinot Noirs. Taste the rich viscosity of flavors of dark currant, plum tart and cherry pastry. Graphite and hot stone notes emerge midpalate, with dark chocolate details and hints of pepper on the finish.

# Red Wines *Continued*



## Sangiovese

**Ruffino** \$53

Tuscany, Italy

Ruby red with purple highlights. Delicate yet persistent violet notes typical of Sangiovese wines. Deep fruity plum flavors with intense sweet cherry flavors.

**Cavaliere d'Oro** \$69

Chianti Classico - Tuscany, Italy

Light garnet color. Aromas of nutmeg, cassis, and earth with a silky, lively, medium body and a smooth, brisk underripe cherry and violet aromas.

**Frescobaldi Nippozano** \$83

Chianti Rufina Riserva - Tuscany, Italy

Its intense ruby red color gives it a bold and elegant character. Red berries and notes of ripe citrus fruit give way to a delicately fruity finish.

**Castello di Gabbiano** \$78

Chianti Classico Riserva - Tuscany, Italy

A very pleasing and inviting aroma of cherry and strawberry plus nice touches of earth, vanilla and spice. The medium-bodied and well-structured wine tastes delicious and is chock-full of juicy black cherry, strawberry and plum with nicely integrated spice and more earthy notes.

**Tenuta Luce Lucente** \$88

Tuscany, Italy

Wonderfully strong and enticing aromas of blackberry and raspberry plus leather, spice and licorice. The wine tastes rich and luscious with tons of delicious ripe, juicy fruit countered by dusty tannins. A fabulous long, dry finish.

**Greppone Mazi by Ruffino** \$124

Brunello di Montalcino

Tuscany, Italy

Full bodied wine with notes of incense, cocoa, sweet tobacco, and spicy black pepper. The palate is refined with an elegant and complex structure.

**Casanova di Neri**

"Tenuta Nuova"

Brunello di Montalcino

Tuscany, Italy

A bright, pure version, boasting raspberry, black cherry and blackberry flavors married to a fluid profile. The structure is present, yet both the lively acidity and fine-grained tannins are in harmony. The focus is really on the fruit here, with accents of graphite, earth, tobacco and underbrush.

## Red Zinfandel

**Vigneti del Salento** \$68

Zolla Primitivo di Manduria

Puglia, Italy

Rich aroma of dark berries, vanilla, oak, and hints of tobacco. Medium - full bodied. Low acidity. Mild tannins. Well balanced with a long finish.

**Gnarly Head Old Vine** \$59

Lodi, California, USA

A gnarly core of rich, jammy blackberries and mocha flavors with layers of spice and vanilla balanced by complex dark fruit aromas.

**Seghesio** \$96

Sonoma County, California, USA

A small amount of Petite Sirah is added to honor century-old traditions and to provide color and structure. The result is a wine that offers tantalizing raspberry, blueberry, classic briary and spicy flavors with a balance of components for which Seghesio wines are known.

**8 Years in the Desert** \$105

Zinfandel Blend

Saint Helena Napa Valley, California, USA

Rich and mouth-filling with ripe flavors of cherry, dark chocolate, coffee and coconut with fine-grained tannins and a persistent finish.

## Malbec

**Marques del Sur**

Reserva de Familia

Mendoza, Argentina

Plum and raspberry aromas mingle elegantly with vanilla notes from the oak. Well balanced, exhibits sweet tannins and a velvety finish.

**Clos de Gamot** \$73

Cahors, France

Inky and slightly cloudy vermillion colour with thick clear legs. Nose of raspberry, ripe plum and red currant. Dry, with plenteous acid. Firm but silky tannins and high alcohol providing plenty of structure.

**Felino** \$80

Mendoza, Argentina

Showing a rich red color with purplish and bluish shades, this wine has a flowery aroma of red berries and vanilla. Notes of chocolate can be tasted in the mouth. Balanced acidity and freshness make this fine Malbec unique, and gently lead to a balanced aftertaste.

**Trivento Golden Reserve**

Mendoza, Argentina

Purple red with deep violet tones. It has a bouquet of berry fruits, plum jam, coffee and tobacco notes. The wine is elegant and powerful on the palate with velvety tannins.

**Bramare**

Lujan de Cuyo-Mendoza, Argentina

The color is deep red with violet hues. It has an intense spicy aroma of pepper, cloves, cinnamon and other spices, ripe black fruits and hints of roses.

**Alta Vista**

Alizarine Single Vineyard

Uco Valley, Argentina

Full bodied, this is a very complex & generous wine, with a great balance & a melange of flavors of sweaty meaty red berry fruit with plum, ethereal almond-infused ripe dark berry fruit, acid liquorice & baking spices.

**Red Schooner by Caymus** \$145

Mendoza, Argentina

This vibrant cherry red opens with a warm, alluring nose. Aromas of ripe plums mix with the rustic scents of the high desert - scrub brush, wild sage, saddle leather, and a hint of pomace. The palate is silky and smooth, with lush plums and grippy tannins that touch the side of the tongue.

## Syrah/Shiraz/Petit Sirah

**Lindemans Bin 50** \$52

Shiraz

South Eastern Australia

It features aromas of vanilla, dark berry fruits with a hint of peppery spice, while the palate shows blackcurrant and plum flavours.

**Penfolds Koonunga Hill** \$61

Shiraz Cabernet

Barossa Valley, South Australia

Oak derived spice makes its presence felt by way of Hungarian paprika and celery salt. There are layers of flavors, the sweetness of hazelnut chocolate balanced by savory pan-seared pancetta, sandalwood and salted nori. A fine line of acid and taly tannins make for a supple and plush mouthfeel.

**Caymus-Suisun**

Grand Durif

Suisun Valley, California, USA

Rich, enveloping scents of French plums and German chocolate cake. A hint of pomace, vanilla, and floral potpourri adds freshness to the nose, while the wood on this wine cradles but never defines the fruit. On the palate, dark berry flavors mingle with tannins, each expanding again and again to march the other.

**Stags' Leap**

Petit Sirah

Napa Valley, California, USA

Very deep purple-black in color, it opens with notes of freshly crushed black cherries and black berries with touches of plum preserves, baking spices and tar. The palate is medium to full-bodied, very firm and grainy with a lively line to lift the peppery black fruit to a long finish.

## Merlot

**Rodney Strong** \$67  
Sonoma County, California, USA

Supple and well oaked aroma, with a toasty, buttery edge to the plum and cherry laced fruit flavors. Body is firm and chunky, but well made.

**Sterling** \$54  
California, USA

Lush and well-spiced, with sinewy power to the dried red currant, plum blackberry cassis and raspberry flavors. Notes of slate and hot stone show on the chiseled finish.

**Clos des Confidences**  
**Grand Cru** \$79  
St Emilion, France
